The MWK **Workshop in Ethnographic Research Methods** is meant as a space where scholars, whose research projects are based on ethnographic qualitative research and self-collected data – obtained by interviewing, observational and interactive methods - will get aware of and discuss specific ethical, practical and methodological issues related to the research process.

Fields for discussion can be:

1. Ethical dilemmas that are linked with the research practice.
2. Reflexivity as a self-critical introspection and self-conscious analytical scrutiny.
3. “Agency of the field” –field interactions, external conditions of research and their impact on research process and research results.
4. Contemporary scholarship on innovative research methods that arise from the changing fieldwork environments as a main feature of “the world in flux” (mobile methodologies, virtual/cyber ethnography, audio-visual methods, etc.)

The sessions are designed as series of interactive workshops.

The workshop addresses all MWK members – pre-doc, doc, post-doc, junior and senior fellows and other associated members of the MWK.
