

Health insurance:	EU countries/Turkey: Exchange students must present the European
	Health Insurance Card (EHIC) / an AT11 (Turkey) that they have received from
	their national insurance company shortly before arrival.
AOK Plus	Other countries without a bilateral agreement (non-EU): Health
	insurance/travel insurance is not recognised and is not sufficient for
	matriculation and registration. Students up to the age of 30 must take out
	statutory health insurance in Germany, for example through AOK Plus.
	Costs for statutory student health insurance: approx. 125 € per month.
