Comments

The fellowships of the associate fellows are usually awarded for 12 months. They usually start on October 1 or April 1 of each year.

The selection procedure is as follows:

1. eligibility check by the directors
2. expert opinion by peers
3. interview with the selection committee
4. decision by the Board of Trustees

The fellows find a stimulating research and working environment and the staff helps with administrative issues (mobility, proofreading, organizational matters, etc.), the student assistants help with academic issues (bibliography, editing, copying, organization of workshops, etc.).
